## **How to Read the Chart**

-The green columns have items to complete each day.

-The other columns require you to choose 2 per week, but if your child is a fast finisher, please feel free to do more.

-We will start at-home Otter Creek 3 times per week. Your child's test will be out loud. In order to pass, your child will need to say the problem and the correct answer and reach their goal in 90 seconds. Please keep track of the levels your child passes. When we come back together, I will give your child a test where he/she left off at home.

-A note for parents about IXL: As we get into more complex topics during the year, some students may take an excessively long time trying to complete an assignment (or receive a Smart Score of 100). You may tell your child he/she may stop an assignment when they reach a Smart Score of 80 as this shows proficiency at that skill.
